

Operation Overnight: Meal Information

No meal packages are offered for the Operation Overnight program. Please read the following meal planning recommendations, tips, and frequently asked questions. Each group has designated chow times to eat in the CPO. Please see your POD for your specific times.

All food brought on board must be eaten in the Chief Petty Officers' (CPO) Mess Hall; no food is allowed in the berthing areas.

BRING YOUR OWN

Personal food items can be brought for any or all the meals your group will consume while staying on board. Groups are welcome to bring food items on board the ship, preferably in sealable bags and/or containers with a lid. Please plan to bring your own utensils, plates, napkins, and beverages.

Each group is assigned refrigerator space and pantry storage. If campers are bringing their own snacks, please have them separated from the rest of their gear, as these items will need to be stored in the pantry during checkin.

Can I prepare meals on board?

- Food preparation on the ship is very limited. Prepackaged food items and meals requiring little to no assembly are preferred.
- O Guests are not permitted to cook on the property.
- O Microwaves, toasters, and an electric tea kettle are available for guest use.

How do I transport food items to the ship?

Groups are responsible for transporting food items from the parking lot to the ship. Personal
collapsible wagons are permitted to assist with load in. Inquire with staff about borrowing one of
the Museum's push carts or wagons.

OFF-SITE DINING

Groups are welcome to depart Patriots Point Museum and dine at a local restaurant. You must be back on the ship by 8pm for a mandatory fire drill. If you are staying two nights, you will only participate in this drill on your <u>first night</u>. On your second night, guests are required to return to the ship by 10:30pm.



ORDER FOOD

Groups are welcome to order food from local restaurants/catering companies for pick-up or delivery. Meals will be eaten in the CPO mess, should you want to dine on the ship.
