WHAT TO EXPECT

SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS

There are no multi-gender sleeping compartments. An adult chaperone <u>must</u> be in each berthing compartment youth are sleeping and must include the appropriate number of female and male chaperones based on the gender, number, and age of campers.

LUGGAGE & BELONGINGS

The Yorktown is located at the end of a 600-foot-long pier. Campers must be able to carry their luggage from the parking area down the pier to the ship. Guests are not permitted to drive cars down the pier for any reason. Please pack with this in mind!

PARKING

Bus parking is free. Vehicles are \$16.45 per vehicle per day:

- When you arrive, scan the QR code to the right.
- One parking pass is required per vehicle per day.
- Passes expire at 1 pm the following day, no matter when you arrive.

Groups <u>must</u> arrive between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm. See below for a sample itinerary:

PACKING LIST

Each berthing unit has central heating and air conditioning and access to restrooms with showers. Only a bare mattress is provided for each bunk.

We recommend the following packing list:

- · Backpack or small bag
- · Seasonally appropriate clothing
- · Closed-Toe Shoes
- · Sleeping bag or bedding for twin
- Pillow
- Soap + Shampoo
- Toothbrush + Toothpaste
- Towel + Wash cloth
- Shower Shoes (recommended)
- Other toiletries + medications
- Water bottle (filling stations on ship)
- Bug spray
- Sunscreen
- · A multi outlet adapter/extension cord



Berthing compartments are climate-controlled and equipped with limited electrical outlets. If you use a Nebulizer or CPAP machine, we suggest bringing a power strip.

NOTE: Vending machines only take credit cards or \$1 bills.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

GROUP SIZE & AGE

A group must have a **minimum of 10 people** to book. The minimum age to participate the program is **7 years old**.

CHAPERONES

Adult to camper ratios vary depending on age:

Ages 7-10 | Must have one adult chaperone per child

Ages 11-17 | Must have one adult chaperone for every 10 campers

BERTHING QUARTERS

Campers sleep right where sailors once slept - in bunks on the USS Yorktown! Bunks are divided into male and female berthing areas. Groups must have the required number of male and female adults to accompany youth. Food is not permitted in the berthing quarters.

PAYMENT

Full payment is **due no later than 45 days prior** to the group's arrival. Payments must be made in one transaction via credit card. Your deposit will be applied to your order.

CANCELLATIONS

Groups may decrease their reservation headcount **up to 30 days before** their Operation Overnight date. Additional individuals may be added to the reservation **up to 2 weeks before** your reservation date, subject to space availability.

MEAL OPTIONS

Meals are not included. Guests may bring their own food, order food for pick-up/delivery or eat off-site. Each group has a designated time to dine in the CPO Mess and will be assigned limited refrigerator and dry goods storage space for their food items. Please see your Plan of the Day (POD) or a staff member for your assigned meal times.

GET READY FOR YOUR OVERNIGHT

ADVENTURE ABOARD THE USS YORKTOWN!

SAFETY ON THE SHIP

- Security and fire safety officers will be on duty during your stay.
- Medication, including over-the-counter products, must be carried and stored by adults. Our team can assist with those that require refrigeration.
- The Fire Marshal mandates all persons sleeping aboard the USS Yorktown
 participate in a fire drill and must physically traverse the planned
 emergency escape route during the first night of their visit.
- NO running, skipping, yelling, pushing, or horseplay. Please walk everywhere you go while on the ships and pier.
- DO NOT touch, adjust, or play on aircraft and museum exhibits; these are very important artifacts.
- Do not play on, climb on or crawl under any plane. They are historic artifacts and must be treated with care.
- DO NOT enter any area of the museum that says do not enter. No one is allowed on the catwalks or in any other berthing area but your own.
- Youth sailors are not allowed to go anywhere by themselves. You may use the buddy system, but adults and chaperones must know where you are at all times.
- NO alcohol, firearms, knives, weapons, or flame-producing devices of any kind are permitted. No open-flame cooking or grilling on property.
- SMOKING is not allowed on any of the ships, pier, flight deck or Vietnam Experience. SMOKING is only allowed in designated smoking areas.
- Tampering with the heat, fire, or smoke detectors is punishable with a \$1500 fine.
