The PPDA Board consists of nine members appointed to serve four-year terms. The selection of three board members, including its chairman, is at the governor's discretion. In addition, five members are appointed by the governor upon the recommendation of a combination of the Speaker of the House, Senate Pro Tem, Senate





Finance Chairman, Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee, and the adjutant general. The mayor of the Town of Mount Pleasant serves as an ex-officio member.
