This budget-friendly promotion has become a tradition for families seeking a fun and affordable way to start the new year after a busy holiday season.

Pay-What-You-Can purchases must be made at the ticket booth. The standard museum admission rate is \$28 for adults (ages 13-61); children under six are free. Each admission ticket includes access to the historic USS Yorktown, USS Laffey, Medal of Honor Museum, and Vietnam Experience. Parking is not included; standard rates apply.
