Tickets are \$95 and include access to the WWII aircraft carrier starting at 7 p.m. In addition to unmatched Harbor views before the fireworks, guests will enjoy live music from local bands: Keith's Dead, Majors Family, and Trae Pierce & the T-Stones.

Guests are encouraged to bring folding chairs.

Patriots Point Naval & Maritime Museum will close early at 3:00 p.m., with the last ticket sold at 2:00 p.m. Only event ticket holders will be allowed to keep their vehicles parked in the lot after this time.
